The theme is **The Call to Covenant** and sessions look at:

**18th April** - A Kingdom without Walls, **9th May** - Social Justice: Realising God's Vision, **30th May** - Incarnation: Divinely human, **6th June** - Prayer: Intimacy with God, **20th June** - Compassion: The heart of Jesus's ministry, **27th June** - Creative Transformation, **11th July** - Embracing Mystery
