Welcome to the St Martin-in-the-Fields Church Music Programme for April 2010.

The Choir of St Martin-in-the-Fields sings at the Parish Eucharist and Choral Evensong each Sunday and this is complemented by extra seasonal services – particularly during Advent, Christmas, Holy Week and Easter. In addition, the Choir sings several concerts per year both at St Martin's and at external venues of note, including a tour to Ireland in May 2010. They also pursue a busy schedule of recordings and broadcasts, featuring regularly on BBC Radio and Television.

In 2009-10 we are delighted to welcome the return of the St Martin's Choral Scholarship Scheme. Ten choral scholars sing Choral Eucharist at 1.00pm and Choral Evensong at 5.00pm each Wednesday during term time, as well as receiving an extensive programme of training in different aspects of church and choral music.

Occasional services are sung by the St Martin's Occasional Singers, a wider group drawn from the St Martin's community and beyond, who sing one or two services a term in St Martin's.

The St Martin's Taize Music Group leads the music at the Taize service on the first Sunday of each month at 6.30pm.
